Power banks over 160 Wh are banned from both carry-on and checked luggage. When traveling, make sure to keep your battery pack easily accessible. Security personnel may ask to ...

“Portable chargers or power banks containing a lithium ion battery must be packed in carry-on bags,” the agency says.

Yes, security can still ask questions, so carry printed or digital proof that shows your name, flight, power bank watt-hours and the airline contact who approved it.

Yes, you can carry power banks in carry-on bags with you as long as they don't exceed 100Wh (~27,000mAh) in capacity. Any model between 100Wh and 160Wh in capacity requires ...

Seats can crush or damage the battery, which could cause it to overheat or catch fire. Call a cabin crew member immediately--they're trained to retrieve devices safely.

Power banks rated at 100Wh or less are fine to bring aboard the plane. Power banks rated between 100Wh and 160Wh require approval from the airline to be carried on the plane.
