

Can an outdoor power supply blow an electric fan

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What if a fan cannot be located at a power supply?

If the fan cannot be located right at the power supply, or if the entire air flow cannot be directed over it, then the fan chosen will need to have a much larger rating. Some fans are specified with an air speed in linear feet per minute (LFM), while others have a volumetric rating in cubic feet per minute (CFM) or cubic meters per hour (m³/hr).

Where should a fan be located in a power supply?

As previously stated, for general equipment cooling, the fan can be located anywhere so long as the air flows through the heat source components. For a power supply that is designed to be force-cooled, the amount of air flowing over it is critical for correct and reliable operation.

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How does a fan work?

Since air always follows the path of least resistance, only a portion of the air pushed by the fan will reach the power supply where it is needed. Internal panels for directing airflow (baffles) will help channel air along the required path to reach and cool the target components.
