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Title: Hidden dangers of rooftop solar photovoltaic power generation

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What are the risks facing rooftop solar?

Swiss Re constantly tracks the shifting risk landscape of energy transition, as detailed on our Renewable Energy Risks page. There are three broad categories of risk facing rooftop solar: Installation and maintenance of PV systems. Failure to properly manage solar installations can lead to fire, which, while infrequent, can be high in severity.

Are rooftop solar systems safe?

The US Inflation Reduction Act has many incentives to expand the use of solar power. Under normal operating conditions, rooftop PV systems do not pose health, safety or environmental risks if properly designed, installed and maintained. However, rooftop solar increases the value at risk compared to ground mounted systems (see Figure 1).

Are solar photovoltaic panels safe?

Demand for solar power is rising in a context of high energy prices and the drive towards a low-carbon future. But, as a new Emerging Risk Trend Talk report from Allianz Commercial highlights, the installation of solar photovoltaic panels introduces risks that must be mitigated if the potential of this power source is to be safely harnessed.
