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How many solar panels can you put on a 600 sq ft roof?

You want to put solar panels on (due to 75% available area, the viable roof area is 450 sq ft, the calculator accounts for that). Just slide the slider to '600' and you get the results: You can put a 7.763 kW solar system on a 600 sq ft roof. If you use only 100-watt panels, you will be able to fit 77 of them on the roof.

How much space do solar panels need?
