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How much wind can a patio umbrella withstand?

Here's how much wind a patio umbrella can withstand on average. Note: Generally speaking, a 9-foot diameter outdoor umbrella with a 100-lb+weighted base can withstand winds up to around 15-20 mph (24-32 km/h). However, keep in mind that wind gusts can exceed this limit, so it's better to play it safe and close up the shade when in doubt.

Why do outdoor umbrellas have different wind ratings?

A specific outdoor umbrella model can have varying wind ratings due to factors like: If you browse our selections, you may notice that an umbrella's wind rating goes down the bigger it gets. An octagonal canopy 5.0 metres in diameter only has half the wind rating as one that's half the size. Square canopies also exhibit this trend.

Engineer wind rating is a method where structural engineers assess the design and materials of the umbrella.

What is a good wind rating for a commercial umbrella?

Good quality commercial-grade market umbrellas will typically have a wind rating of 50km/h or more. The wind rating usually presumes that the umbrella is installed in or fixed to the ground. If used on a moveable base, the size of the base (footprint) and the gross weight of the base will greatly impact the wind rating of the umbrella.
