Are solar panels subject to a tariff?

Imports above quota limits are subject to a 9.6% import tariff. Decreasing quantitative limits are set from 2024 to 2027. From 2028 onwards, solar panels imports are expected to be subject to a 9.6% import tariff.

What is a 5 GW tariff quota?

By the end of July, there was a 5 GW tariff rate quota (TRQ) for cells. On August 12, the U.S. raised the annual TRQ for cells from 5 GW to 12.5 GW, which is applied to cells imported after August 1, 2024, while imports exceeding the old 5 GW limit before August 1 are subject to the Section 201 tariffs.

When does the Section 201 tariff quota expire?

As of 2024, the Section 201 tariff rate for cells and modules is 14.25%, with a yearly decrease of 0.25%, set to expire on February 6, 2026. In May 2024, the U.S. removed the tariff exemption for bifacial modules. By the end of July, there was a 5 GW tariff rate quota (TRQ) for cells.
