These 30 countries collectively have a population of 44 million. Out of these 30 countries, 23 (approximately 76.7%) have not documented any academic research in the field of solar energy.

Which states have large solar power plants?

Other states with large solar power plants include Texas, Florida, and North Carolina. The global solar PV capacity is expected to hit 1.3 terawatts (TW) by 2023. Solar PV capacity grew from about 5 gigawatts in 2005 to roughly 940 gigawatts in 2021. Solar Energy Statistics state that solar energy is the most abundant energy source on Earth.
